The maximum number of participants per course is 15.

After presentation of the training and upon completion of a brief questionnaire certificates are issued to all participants.

Course A - Warden Training which takes approximately 1.5-2 hours to deliver covers the following topics:

- Ways fire can spread
- Classes of Fire
- Fire Extinguisher Selection and Identification
- Method of Operation
- Fire Fighting Safety
- Fire Blankets & Hose Reels
- Demonstration of the use of Fire Extinguishers

All participants are given the opportunity to use a fire extinguisher on a controlled flame.

Information sheet - Courses

Course C - Fire Awareness, Warden & Use of Portable Fire Fighting Equipment combined course which takes approximately 2 - 2.5 hours to deliver covers the following topics:

- Fire Safety
- Understanding Fire
- Standards
- Building Profile
- Alert and Evacuation Tone Procedures
- Refusal, Unconsciousness, Special Needs
- Bomb Threats
- Evaluating Evacuation Performance
- Portable Fire Extinguishers
- Fire Blankets
- Fixed Fire Hose Reels
- First Attack Procedures

All participants are given the opportunity to use a fire extinguisher on a controlled flame.

All training also includes a PowerPoint presentation and video. I have a laptop and data projector and would require the use of a suitable area for this purpose.

The cost of Courses A & B is \$500 (ex GST) per course, per session.

The cost of Course C is \$800 (ex GST) per session.

It is recommended that this training be repeated every 6 - 12 months.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Secure on-site parking is required for the trainer's vehicle for the duration of the training program.
- The price per session is the total cost, and includes all material (including manuals and certificates) and extinguishers supplied from training stock, and the recharge of all extinguishers used.
